

FLYING RESTRICTIONS

DUE THE ERECTION OF THE WIND TURBINE TO THE SOUTH WEST OF THE FLYING FIELD THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS ARE IN PLACE:

- THE PILOTS STANCE TO THE WEST (Right hand stance as seen from car-park) CANNOT BE USED.
- MODELS FLYING EASTERLY WIND CANNOT EXCEED THOSE POWERED BY A 91 TWO STROKE OR EQUIVALENT.
- ON TAKING OFF FROM THE REMAINING STANCE (In a westerly wind) PILOTS MUST SHORTEN THE CIRCUIT AND TURN ON TO THE CIRCUIT AS SOON AS A SAFE AIRSPEED HAS BEEN ATTAINED TO COMPLETE THE TURN.
- <u>DO NOT</u> FLY IN THE VICINITY OF THE WIND TURBINE.
- VISITING PILOTS MUST HAVE THEIR FLYING ASSESSED AS COMPETENT BY A QUALIFIED PILOT FROM THE CLUB PRIOR TO FLYING WITHOUT A CLUB MEMBER.
